No. GVN/11 /102018/309/E- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) & (2) of section 54 read with section 31A of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 (14 of 1981) and of all other powers enabling in that behalf the Government of Gujarat, after consolation with the state board hereby make the following rules, further to amend the Gujarat Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Rules, 1983, namely.
